LAST YEAR'S COMMUNITY SERVICE AND OUTREACH HIGHLIGHTS INCLUDE:

- Through Valor Inc., provided \$1,000 worth of tents and sleeping bags for homeless veterans.
- Sponsored the Linn County Deputy Sheriff's Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas food basket drives.
- Raised \$35,000 between Cedar Rapids and Waterloo at the 33rd Annual Union Bowling Challenge for MDA.
- Through HACAP, adopted two families of four for Christmas.
- Sponsored the Fish-O-Rama for the Boys and Girls Club.
- Supported veterans during the holidays with \$400 in gas cards, \$300 in gift cards and \$300 worth of meat.
- Sponsored Relay for Life for the American Cancer Society.
