



## Full-Time Youth Achievement AmeriCorps positions:

The Youth Achievement AmeriCorps program is a team of hardworking and dedicated AmeriCorps members who serve in schools, enrichment programs and early literacy programs to help close the achievement gap in the Cedar Rapids Community. Members serve 1700 hours (approximately 35-40 hours a week) at their respective sites over the course of a year.

- Elementary School Tutor Positions: We are looking for qualified individuals to tutor students at local Cedar Rapids elementary schools. These schools include: Grant, Grant Wood, Harrison, Johnson and Van Buren. Intervention is focused on K-3 literacy skills. ([Apply Here](#))
- Enrichment Assistant Positions: We are looking for qualified individuals to assist with the enrichment program, Kids on Course, at three Cedar Rapids elementary schools (Grant, Harrison and Van Buren). ([Apply Here](#))
