It's difficult for low-income families to transition from financial crisis to stability. Providing employment and education opportunities can increase income, but access to stable housing, food, and transportation remains a challenge for people making less than the Federal Poverty Level (FPL).

When basic needs are not met, progress toward financial stability is nearly impossible.

- 18% of Linn County families are below the 200% poverty level
- 42% of Linn County renters are spending more than 30% of their monthly income on housing (housing cost burdened)
- 31,000+ people in East Central Iowa are food insecure
