Women United Goal: Increase the well-being of low-income women (250% of FPL) age 18-54. Outcome: Improve the utilization of physical and mental healthcare systems by:

- Increasing affordability of healthcare
- Decreasing the barriers to access
- · Addressing the social determinants of healthcare

## **Women United Funding Application Directions & Requirements**

This is a renewable three-year grant process, with funding and performance reviewed and renewed annually during the cycle. Funding for the grant cycle of FY21-FY23 will be reviewed and awarded based on the annual Women United campaign results.

### Funding should complete the following:

- 1. Agency Overview
- 2. Application Narrative, limit 5 pages
- 3. WU FY21 Funding Summary (attached)
  - This form shall serve as the primary tool to set context for the # served and the amount of funding being requested for each activity you are proposing.
  - The form will be updated and sent to Karey Chase annually by March 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 4. Funding Priorities will be reviewed and updated annually.

### Deadline: March 6th, 2020 4:30pm

Complete applications should be sent via email to Karey Chase.

- To be considered, complete each proposal including all elements described above.
- Successful applicants will be required to follow the <u>Partner Agency</u> <u>Guidelines</u>

#### Successful applicants will also be asked to provide:

- a) Provide Mid-Year and Year-End reporting; including an updated funding summary
- b) Adherence to the UWECI Counterterrorism Compliance guidelines;
- c) Align with UWECI Diversity and Inclusion Policies demonstrated by the completion of the Affidavit of Non-Discrimination
- d) Compete the Accountability Review Process
