We've been inspired this past year by community champions like you who have helped us foster an environment where everyone can thrive. The growth we've accomplished has shown us the potential of cultivating deeper solutions to address our communities' top needs of housing, childcare, and safety net services.

You have likely heard of our updated funding process that was reconstructed in conjunction with our *Unite to Inspire* focus areas, with vulnerable populations and racial equity at the forefront. Everything that contributed to the new funding process is part of UWECI's building blocks to support healthy and secure lives for individuals and families.

We continue to integrate our *Unite to Inspire* strategies into our work and act creatively to find more opportunities for people to make a greater impact. UWECI volunteers brought \$2.4 million back into the community through our Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program, which provides financial stability to local individuals and families, further building economic mobility. Women United's annual Power of the Purse event raised a new record of more than \$32,000 for its mission to further improve access to healthcare for un- and under-insured women.

This work are examples of what can be accomplished through collaborations and partnerships among our United Way supporters. This year, we are asking the question, "What inspires you?"
